

HCS Snow Removal Procedures

*The threshold to start cleaning driveways from our contractor is 5 inches, measured after the storm is over and to begin after Berkeley plows the streets (not predicted amount). Berkeley township will begin to plow at 2" (see attached from Berkeley Township website about their snow removal procedures).

* If you don't want your driveway plowed, we have flags that you can pick up at the office, for free and you can put them out along the edge. Other options are: leave your car in the driveway towards the back-end apron and/or put magnetic reflectors on your garage door. Remember, once they start cleaning the driveways you will need to move your cars out of the driveway so that he can plow.

* Contractor stays 2 feet away from the garage door, please don't open the door and ask him to do closer. They do not provide hand shoveling or salting.

* Our contractor is not responsible if Berkeley Township plows you in after your private contractor cleans your driveway.

* Clubhouse property is always cleaned of snow regardless of the amount.

* Please don't call the office until after the storm is done and the contractors have ample time to do the cleanup.



SNOW PLOW AND SALTING PROCEDURES

At the start of a snow storm, salt and sanding vehicles are dispatched in Berkeley Township. Major roadways are usually done first, followed by secondary roadways. After the snow has stopped and it has been determined that accumulations have exceeded 2" to 3", the Township will begin to snowplow.

The Township will utilize approximately 70 pieces of Township equipment and approximately 30 contracted loaders for cul-de-sacs. All streets are opened curb to curb to insure the drains are opened. Sanding and salting operations continue as needed.

Each snowplow vehicle has been assigned a section to plow and will remain in that section until all roadways have been sufficiently cleaned. This may require the snowplow vehicle to make multiple passes on each street. Township forces will be plowing each street from curb to curb during each snowfall. On occasion, due to the lack of areas between the sidewalk and curb, sidewalks and driveway aprons may become covered with snow that falls off the Snowplow blade.

Township forces will not remove snow from any sidewalk or driveway apron in these instances. We regret this unfortunate inconvenience. At no time is snow to be disposed into the street from the property, parking lots, driveways and sidewalks. All snow blowers should be directed to blow snow back onto the property.

After the streets are plowed and salted, snow deposited back into the roadway creates hazardous situations, causes additional plowing of the streets and blocking of parked vehicles and driveways after the original cleanup. Summonses could be issued for non-compliance. We want to thank everyone for complying with these requests and following the ordinances, rules and regulations of the Township of Berkeley.



TREES IN THE COMMUNITY

Recently we have had several severe storms. Many of us have had tree limbs and or trees fall. The rule of thumb regarding these fallen trees and/or tree limbs is simple. If a tree or tree limb(s) that are in the common area fall in the common area, we leave the downed tree and/or tree limbs where they fall, unless they are creating a hazard. If a tree or tree limbs from the common area fall onto a member's property, the association will remove them. If a tree and /or tree limb do damage to a homeowner's home, they will have to file through their homeowner's insurance for damages, but the association will have the tree and/or tree limbs removed. Also, if the downed tree and/or tree limbs from a tree are from one that stood on the homeowner's property or the township right of way, the homeowner has responsibility for any damage they may cause. This should clarify the association policy for downed trees and/or tree limbs. If a homeowner has a tree on their property and would like to have it removed and are not sure if that tree is on their property for sure, please call the Code Committee and have them come check on it before removing anything. Berkeley Township requires that you have a permit to remove trees.



This pertains to any changes, additions, or alterations on the exterior of the home - roof, siding, paint, driveway, patio, sheds, etc.

Absolutely **NO WORK** can be started without permission from the Homeowners' Association or without a permit. **FINES WILL BE IMPOSED if this is not adhered to.**

GARBAGE NOTICE

Garbage is **NOT** to be put out to the curb **before 4:00 PM on Mondays**. This is a Berkeley Township Ordinance and HCS residents must comply. Violators may be issued a fine for non-conformance by the Township and/or HCS. Trash receptacles must be kept in your garage, behind your home, or in an area out of view from the street. Receptacles must be covered and concealed. If you are away, consider having a friend or neighbor place your garbage cans at the curb and return them to their respective out-of-view locations after trash pickup.

With the outbreak of the **COVID-19 virus**, Berkeley Sanitation Department's rules for putting out trash is as follows: ***The Township has made key changes to trash pickup. All household trash must be bagged and placed in an outdoor trash receptacle. Sanitation employees will not pick up trash that is not bagged.***

Everyone stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call Taken: All Trustees in attendance.

Financials: Operating account is \$299,763.56. The reserve account is \$975,060.44.

Minutes: Minutes from our December homeowners meeting are posted in the January Southwind.

Code Change: The county approved a 6-foot stockade privacy fence for residents who are along Mule Road. The fence is to be on the back of the lot and not surrounding the rear of the house.

Outstanding Lawsuit: One outstanding lawsuit is still pending (under old insurance company-Selective). Insurance company/lawyers are playing games.

Outdoor Basketball Court: Is approved with the basketball hoop not to exceed a \$700 purchase.

Volleyball Net: Is approved to purchase for the pool.

Exercise Room: Is still in the planning stage, getting equipment bids and location in Bldg. B.

Bingo: Will continue when the license transfer is complete. Volunteers are needed. A robo call will announce the date when bingo will begin again. A phone chain will be implemented in informing others outside of HCS of bingo information. Volunteers can meet at the Friday ticket sales.

Snow Removal: The contractor missed many streets and driveways during the previous snowstorm which is being addressed with the Mayor and DPW. Driveway snow removal instructions are in the Southwind.

MONTHLY BLACK HISTORY MONTH

Preventing Slips, Trips & Falls

KNOW THE RISKS

Slips and trips are two of the most frequent causes of injury in the workplace and cost employers millions every year. However, the majority of accidents caused by slips and trips can be easily avoided by following a few simple guidelines.

By following the principles set out in this poster, you can ensure that your workplace is free from slip and trip hazards and that accidents are kept to a minimum.

1. HAZARD - SPILLAGES

Spillages

Clean spills up at once. Remember that the cleaning agent needed will depend on the nature of the spill. If the floor remains wet after the spill has been cleaned, make sure people are aware of this by using appropriate signs. Arrange a diverted route that avoids the area if necessary.

2. HAZARD - CABLES

Cables

Try to make sure that cables do not cross walkways. Use cable curbs and tunnels to prevent trips if necessary.

3. HAZARD - OBSTRUCTIONS

Obstructions

Permanent obstructions and any objects left lying around can easily create a trip hazard if they are not seen. Keep work areas clear of obstructions. If this is not possible, use appropriate signs or barriers to make people aware of hazards.

4. HAZARD - FLOORING

Flooring

Look for any cracks, holes or uneven wear etc that may cause a trip hazard. If the floor regularly becomes wet or slippery through working procedures, consider how this can be contained or prevented.

5. HAZARD - FOOTWEAR

Footwear

Choice of footwear can be crucial in preventing slips and trips. If special footwear is needed to ensure the safety of employees, the employer must provide it.

6. HAZARD - LIGHTING

Lighting

Lighting should be adequate enough to enable people to see obstructions and hazards. Ensure that faulty lights are replaced and dirty lights are cleaned before levels become too low for people to work in safety.

7. PREVENTING ACCIDENTS

An effective management system will enable you to:

- Ascertain any slip and trip problems.
- Identify the best course of action.
- Execute your chosen course of action.
- Evaluate the effectiveness of your precautions.

You should try to incorporate the following steps into your system:

1. Ask which areas of your workplace contain slip and trip hazards and devise a strategy for improvement. Minimise slip and trip hazards through effective equipment and working procedures.
2. Make sure workers are aware of slip and trip risks and are committed to minimising them. Give people safety responsibilities. Ensure a record is kept of who is responsible for what.
3. Carry out regular checks to ensure that any safety procedures are being carried out properly. Keep a record of cleaning and maintenance work.
4. Review the approach to slip and trip issues on a regular basis and examine accident reports.



Chocolate Raspberry Lava Cake

Ingredients:

4 oz. semisweet chocolate, chopped

4 tbsp unsalted butter

2 large eggs

2 large egg yolks

1/4 c. granulated sugar

2 tbsp all-purpose flour

1/4 c. raspberry preserves

Powdered sugar and fresh raspberries for garnish

Instructions:

Preheat your oven to 425°F. Grease 4 ramekins and dust lightly with cocoa powder.

In a microwave-safe bowl, melt the chocolate and butter together in 30-second intervals until smooth. Let cool slightly.

In another bowl, whisk eggs, egg yolks, and sugar until thick and pale. Gradually fold the chocolate mixture into the egg mixture. Sift in the flour and mix until just combined.

Divide the batter into the ramekins. Add a teaspoon of raspberry preserves into the center of each and cover with more batter.

Bake for 12–14 minutes or until the edges are set, but the center remains soft.

Cool cakes for 1 minute before inverting onto plates. Garnish with powdered sugar and fresh raspberries.




