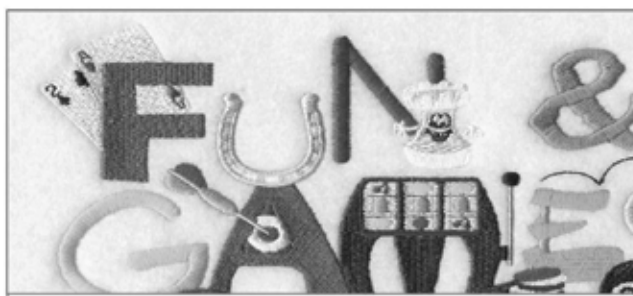

We hope that everyone is enjoying the Summer thus far and are keeping safe and cool. 250th America's Birthday celebrations were awesome.

Legislation Update S1526:

Sponsored by Senator Carmen Amata: On May 18, 2026 this proposed legislation was referred to the Budget and Finance Committee. S1526 increases fines on scammers stealing identity of a senior citizen.

Legislation Update: S4306:

Sponsored by Senator Carmen Amato. If passed, S4306 will make permanent the additional \$250 property tax benefit for certain senior citizen homeowners and tenants:

- Homeowners 65 years of age or older with a gross income not to exceed \$250,000 for the tax year that is used to determine such resident homestead owner's eligibility for the \$250 Anchor Property Tax Relief Program.
- Renters 65 years of age or older whose homestead is a residential rental property with gross income not in excess of \$150,000 for the tax year that is used to determine eligibility of the Anchor Property Tax Relief Program is eligible for an additional benefit in the amount of \$250.

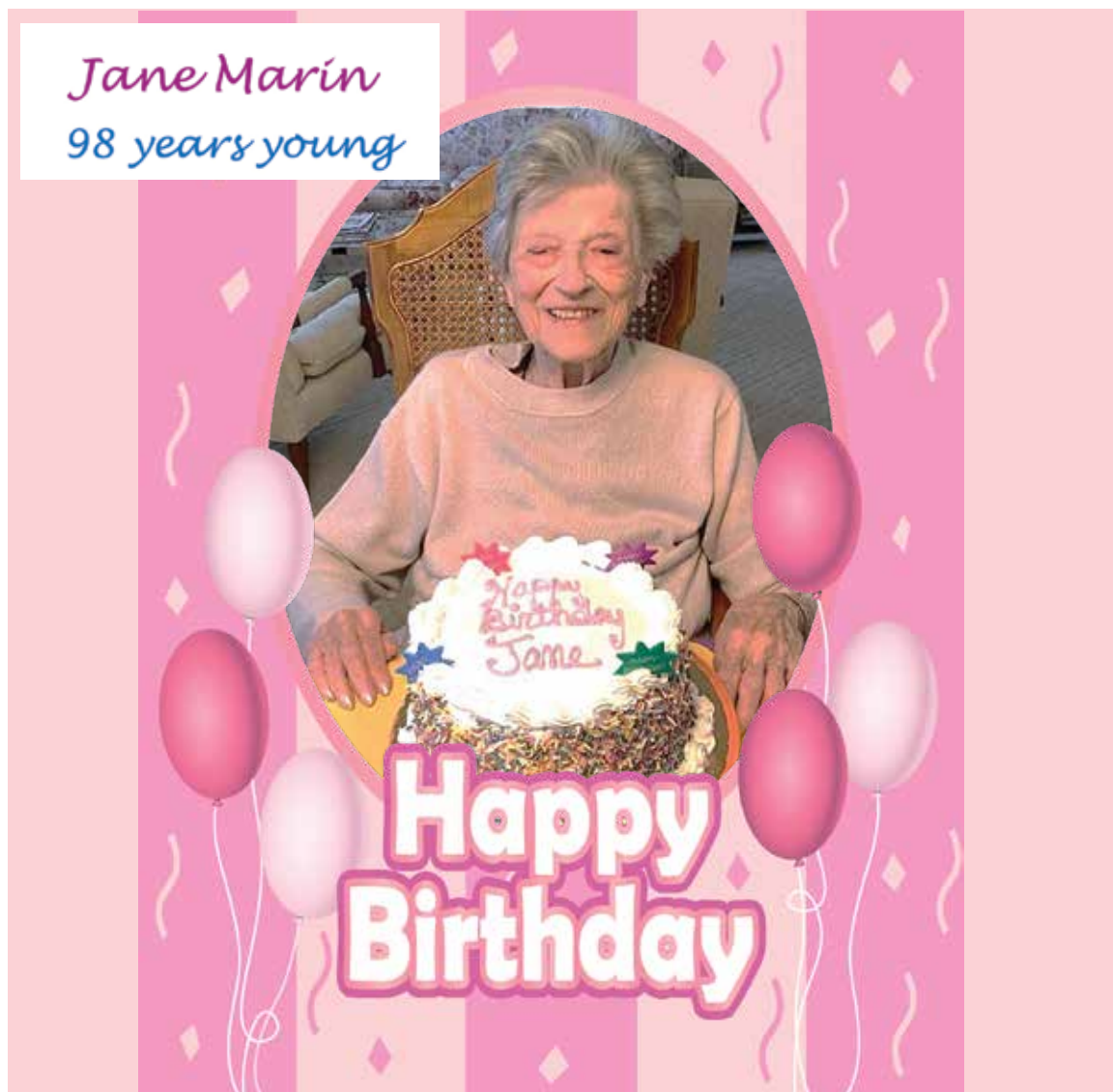

We've also been busy moving several ongoing projects toward completion, including the Fitness Center and new shrubbery plantings around the community. Last month, we experienced an issue with the pool's solar heating system, but repairs have been made, and we hope the water has been warm and comfortable for everyone.

A heartfelt thank you to the residents of Holiday City South for electing me as one of your new Trustees. I am truly privileged to have your trust and support. I will continue to work to keep our community strong and move forward by listening to your concerns, replying with honesty and a commitment to finding results. Thank you.

I want to thank the membership of Holiday City South for your overwhelming support during the recent election. I am honored to have the opportunity to serve on our Board and represent each of you. I am truly humbled by the trust you have placed in me, and I promise to work daily to keep that trust.

Debbie Signorile - Trustee

I am the Trustee that is the Liaison to the Code Committee. The committee received a letter from an unhappy resident that was complaining about things that they were unable to do a couple of years ago and now seeing them being done at other homes.

Residents were asking for change and we responded by making changes that the majority of the homeowners asked for: fence heights and shed placement are among them. Unfortunately, this leads to a situation where you could not do something last year, but you can do it now. This is unavoidable when you make changes to move our community forward.

In the same letter, the resident also states that: "only new homeowners go to the Code Committee, everybody else does anything they want". They were told this by a contractor who claims that he does a lot of work here. Nothing could be further from the truth, any changes to the exterior of your home need to have written approval from the Code Committee. This contractor is giving this resident bad advice.

I am asking this resident to contact me, and I will explain the changes in the codes that were made for the good of all homeowners. When you have a complaint or question, please contact the Board and we will do our best to explain what is going on and hopefully put you at ease. By writing an anonymous letter, we have no way of contacting you to get to the bottom of your complaint. Absolutely **NO** exterior additions, changes, or alterations of any kind can be made until the plans and specifications showing all details are submitted to the Code Committee and approved by the board.

If plans are within the guidelines of our By-Laws, a form will be filled out by the homeowner so they can submit it to the Zoning Board Officer of Berkeley Township, to obtain a permit if needed.

This pertains to any changes, additions, or alterations on the exterior of the home - roof, siding, paint, driveway, patio, sheds, etc.

Absolutely **NO WORK** can be started without permission from the Homeowner's Association or without a permit. ***FINES WILL BE IMPOSED if this is not adhered to.***

GARBAGE NOTICE

Garbage is **NOT** to be put out to the curb **before 4:00 PM on Mondays**. This is a Berkeley Township Ordinance and HCS residents must comply. Violators may be issued a fine for non-conformance by the Township and/or HCS. Trash receptacles must be kept in your garage, behind your home, or in an area out of view from the street. Receptacles must be covered and concealed. If you are away, consider having a friend or neighbor place your garbage cans at the curb and return them to their respective out-of-view locations after trash pickup.

With the outbreak of the **COVID-19 virus**, Berkeley Sanitation Department's rules for putting out trash is as follows: **The Township has made key changes to trash pickup. All household trash must be bagged and placed in an outdoor trash receptacle.** Sanitation employees will not pick up trash that is not bagged.

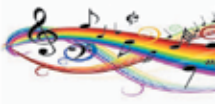

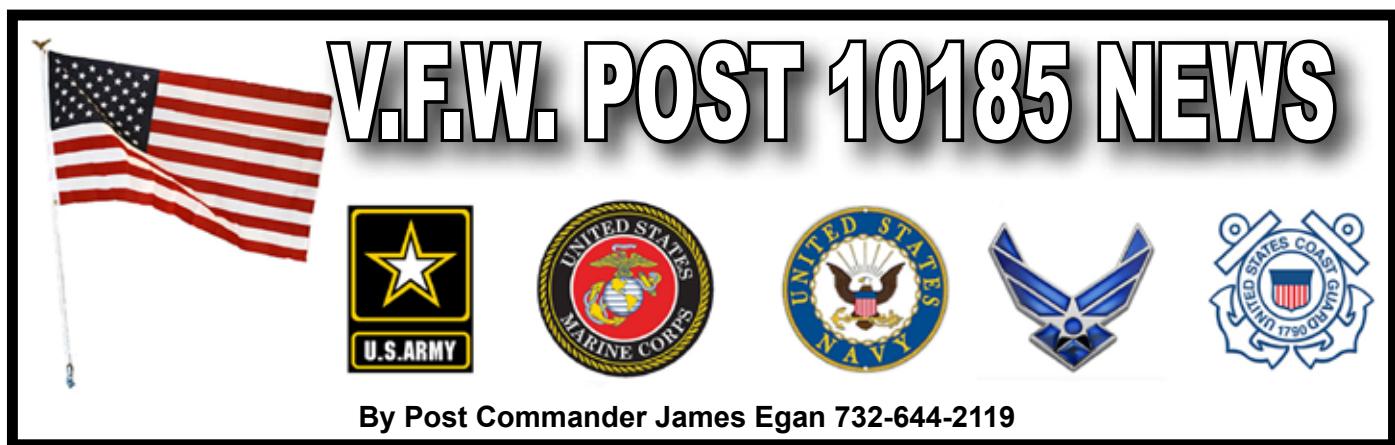

POOL RULES

- ❖ All badge holders must sign in with pool monitor for admittance. Badges must be available for inspection at all times. Two guest badges per household and must be worn on clothing at all times.
- ❖ All persons must shower before entering the water.
- ❖ Any persons showing evidence of any communicable skin disease, sore, inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharge or if they are wearing bandages will be denied admission to the pool area.
- ❖ Do not enter the water if you are experiencing or recovering from diarrhea or have had any symptoms related to a gastrointestinal (stomach) disorder in the past seven (7) days.
- ❖ Children 4 to 18 years of age are permitted into the pool under supervision of an adult between the hours of 9:00 am and 1:00 pm daily. **No child will be permitted in the pool with diapers of any kind.**
- ❖ Children should be encouraged to use the restroom before entering the water. Accompanying adult should immediately report any accidents observed in the bathing waters to a pool monitor.
- ❖ No animals, with the exception of service dogs, will be permitted in the pool area.
- ❖ Long hair and bearded need to be tied up while using the pool. Hair bands are available at the pool monitor station.
- ❖ **No alcohol** of any kind will be permitted in or around the pool area. Drinks must be in a clear plastic container or an approved insulated/thermos container. Glass containers are **prohibited** in or around the pool area.
- ❖ Persons suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be prohibited from entering the pool. Any person found to be drinking alcohol or under the influence of drugs while in the pool area will be escorted from the pool area and denied admittance for the remainder of the pool season.
- ❖ Food or snacks are permitted in the pool area. Coolers no larger than 16" by 16" (with wheels) are permitted.
- ❖ Conduct that endangers the safety and comfort of others is prohibited and could be cause for violators to be escorted from the pool area and denied admittance for the remainder of the pool season.
- ❖ Flotation devices, such as noodles (no longer than the size of the pool monitor's table) and children's water wings/swimmies are permitted in the pool. Any type of inflatable/blow-up tubes, rafts, flippers or swimming devices are not permitted in the pool.
- ❖ Only bathing suits are permitted in the pool. Cut-offs, street clothes or substitute swimwear are not allowed to be worn in the pool.
- ❖ For safety, and as a courtesy to others, please place footwear along the edge of the pool, but not near or around the handrails used to entering or exiting the pool. No jumping in the pool, including from steps or stairs.
- ❖ No smoking or vaping will be allowed by the picnic tables or in the pool area.
- ❖ The pool will be closed, at the discretion of the pool staff or the Trustees, during inclement weather or emergencies.
- ❖ Only music provided by monitor is permitted. No outside music is allowed.
