Thursday... September 10th: Smithville Village – Smithville, NJ: Smithville is home to several cute shops, highly rated restaurants, and lakefront entertainment. Come join us for a day of fun! Bus pick-up begins at 9:30AM. **Call in after 4PM Friday, September 4th.**

Thursday... September 17th: Colombus Flea Market – Colombus NJ: A unique and popular shopping experience awaits at the Colombus Flea and Farmer's Market! Thriving since 1929, the Colombus Market stands as New Jersey's oldest flea and farmer's market. Enjoy products offered by the hundreds of local vendors, ranging from fresh produce,

seafood, baked goods and more. Bus pick-up begins at 9:30AM. **Call in after 4PM Friday, September 11th.**

Thursday... September 24th: Cape May, Washington Street – Cape May, NJ: Cape May is just so different from the other destinations along the Jersey Shore.
